

MOEA, R.O.C. Features River Restoration Microfilm and APP

【2012/11/15】 To consolidate all river restoration information in Taiwan and construct complete river restoration knowledge system, the Water Resources Planning Institute, Water Resources Agency, MOEA, R.O.C. established the Taichung River Restoration Network (TRRN), as the platform for exchange of information and experiences. However, as results from relevant river restoration efforts by the government and private sectors are rarely know to the public, MOEA hopes to promote them with heart-warming microfilms so that audiences can gain a deeper understanding about the river restoration efforts.

The first waves of the microfilms are centered on the Erren River restoration story and the before and after comparison will be featured. To watch this film whenever possible, the Water Resources Planning Institute has developed the first free APP in R.O.C., “Restore Rivers Let’s Go”, to feature updates about river restoration efforts. This educational and entertaining mobile APP not only can play microfilms, but is also further integrated with the LBS positioning feature for users to search for waterfront activities, water quality and aquatic attractions of the nearby rivers and environmental education facilities.
